We were asked by the DSEB "Dancesport Executive Board" about the possibility to change the rule of the European 10 Dance Title Events - to be run in 1 day instead of 2 days due to lack of organizers.

Our response has been the following :

We agree to change the event to a one day competition as long as there can be a few stipulations made for the competitors.

1. There should be a minimum of 20 min. between each round with a maximum of 6 rounds in that one day competition (3 Latin and 3 Standard) if any more then we would encourage them to do it over 2 days.

2. We have a 2 or 3 year trial period so that we can assess the impact on the competitors to see what the change makes.

Additionally a suggestion of a rule change by the DSEB about the Rumba and Quickstep tempi for the WDC Championships was agreed on at the annual WDC Dancesport meeting to:

Rumba 25 BPM And Quickstep 48 BPM
